Plan Your Visit:

- ♥ Tell your team about the medications your child is taking
- ♥ Let your team know if your child has been to the Emergency Room or has been hospitalized
- ♥ Work with your team to create your health care plan, and make sure that you understand how to follow it
- ♥ Always talk openly with your team. If you are having trouble sticking to your health care plan, tell your team about what is not working so you can make changes together as needed
