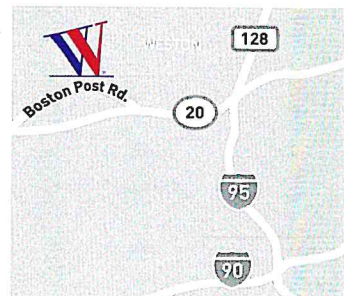

Referrals: It is very important that your provider help coordinate your child's health care, including referrals, to ensure that the most appropriate specialist sees your child and has the medical information they need to provide care.

You can also access and print school and camp forms, as well as lab and test results through Patient Gateway. DIRECTIONS

From North: Take RT-128S to the US-20 exit, Exit 26, towards Waltham/RT-117/Weston. Bear right onto RT-20 West, Weston/Marlboro. Travel 1 mi., bear right at the brick church onto Boston Post Road. Travel 0.6 mi. through Weston Center, our building is on your left.



From South: Take RT-128N to the US-20 exit, Exit 26, towards Waltham/RT-117/Weston. Bear left and enter the rotary, following signs to US-20 West to Weston/Marlboro. Travel half of the way around the rotary and bear right toward Rt. 20 West, Weston/Marlboro. Travel 1 mi., bear right at the brick church onto Boston Post Road. Travel 0.6 mi. through Weston Center, until you see our building on your left.

From West: Travel on RT-20 until you see signs for Weston Center 1 (Boston Post Rd). Bear left onto Boston Post Road. Our building is located 0.8 mi. on the right.

From East: Travel on MA Turnpike West to Exit 15 (Routes 95/128/30, Waltham/Weston). Follow signs for 95N: (95-128, Waltham/Dedham), (95/128/N30, NH/Maine, Points North), (95 N. Waltham/Portsmouth, NH). Travel one exit on 95 North to Exit 26: RT-20, Waltham/Weston. On off ramp, follow signs for RT-20 West to Weston/Marlboro. Travel half of the way around the rotary and bear right onto RT-20 west, Weston/Marlboro. Travel 1 mile, bear right at the brick church onto Boston Post Road. Travel 0.6 mi. through Weston Center, our building is on your left.

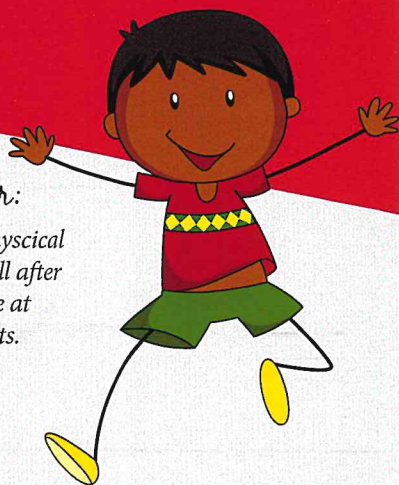

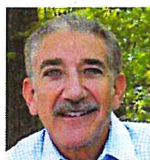
